

ORDINANCE NO. 090-013

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, RESCINDING THE ORDER AND NOTICE OF THE ELECTION CONTAINED IN ORDINANCE NO. 089-009 ORDERING AN ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE TOWN OF ADDISON, ON THE 5TH DAY OF MAY, 1990, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING ONE PROPOSITION RELATIVE TO REMAINING OR WITHDRAWING FROM DALLAS AREA RAPID TRANSIT AUTHORITY TO QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 089-009; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That on April 25, 1989, the City Council of the Town of Addison, Texas, duly passed Ordinance Number 089-009 ordering an election to be held in the Town of Addison, on the 5th day of May, 1990, for the purpose of submitting one proposition relative to remaining or withdrawing from Dallas Area Rapid Transit Authority to qualified voters of the Town of Addison.

SECTION 2. That the City Council finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Addison, Texas, to rescind the Order and Notice of the Election contained in Ordinance No. 089-009, and it does hereby so rescind such Order and Notice.

SECTION 3. That Ordinance No. 089-009 is hereby repealed.


SECTION 4. That a copy of this rescission of notice and order of special municipal election shall be mailed certified mail, postage prepaid to the Executive Committee (Directors of the Dallas Area Rapid Transit Authority who are serving as the governing body of the authority), the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation, and the Comptroller of Public Accounts.

SECTION 5. The terms and provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be severable, and if the validity of any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be declared to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. The public importance of rescission of a special municipal election constitutes an emergency and creates a necessity for the immediate preservation of the public business, property, health and safety of the citizens of the City which requires that this ordinance be passed and take effect as an emergency measure, and it is accordingly so ordained that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
