ORDINANCE NO. 092-056

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 14, SIGNS, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, SO AS TO GRANT A MERITORIOUS EXCEPTION TO THE CITY'S SIGN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR TWO TEMPORARY BANNERS TO BE HUNG FOR 30 DAYS PRIOR TO OKTOBERFEST '92, ON APPLICATION FROM THE TOWN OF ADDISON, LOCATED AT ON BELT LINE AT QUORUM DRIVE, AND ON THE EAST FACADE OF THE GRAND KEMPINSKI HOTEL, PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. In accordance with Section 14-118 of the Sign Ordinance a meritorious exception is hereby granted to the Town of Addison to allow two temporary banners to be hung 30 days prior to a Special event (Oktoberfest).

SECTION 2. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense and that each day such violation shall continue to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provisions thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole.
