

ORDINANCE NO. 093-035

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER SIX (FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION), ARTICLE III (FIRE DEPARTMENT GENERALLY), DIVISION 2 (EMERGENCY AMBULANCE SERVICE), SECTION 54 (ESTABLISHING FEES) OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON CODE OF ORDINANCES; AND CALLING FOR AN EMERGENCY.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS; THAT,

SECTION 1. That Section 6-54 (Establishing Fees) of the Town of Addison Code of Ordinances be amended in its entirety as shown below:


A fee of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) shall be charged per trip, per person, for the transportation by ambulance of a person, or persons, to a hospital, doctor's office or any other place providing emergency medical aid, in response to an emergency call received by the dispatcher for emergency ambulance service.

SECTION 2. The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
