ORDINANCE NO. 094-018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 14, SIGNS, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, SO AS TO GRANT A MERITORIOUS EXCEPTION TO THE CITY'S SIGN ORDINANCE TO ALLOW ONE ATTACHED "TOM THUMB" SIGN WITH LETTERS SIXTY-EIGHT (68) INCHES AND TWENTY-FOUR (24) INCHES IN HEIGHT AND A SQUARE FOOTAGE OF ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY (170) SQUARE FEET, ONE "FOOD" SIGN WITH LETTERS OF TWENTY-FOUR (24) INCHES AND TWENTY (20) INCHES IN HEIGHT AND A SQUARE FOOTAGE OF SEVENTEEN AND ONE HALF (17.5) SQUARE FEET, ONE "PHARMACY" SIGN WITH LETTERS TWENTY-FOUR (24) INCHES AND TWENTY (20) INCHES IN HEIGHT AND A SQUARE FOOTAGE OF THIRTY-TWO (32) SQUARE FEET, ON APPLICATION FROM TOM THUMB #43, LOCATED AT 14280 MARSH LANE, PROVIDING FOR SPECIAL CONDITIONS, PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. In accordance with Section 14-118 of the Sign Ordinance a meritorious exception is hereby granted to Tom Thumb #43, located at 14280 Marsh Lane, to allow three attached signs with letters that are from twenty (20) inches in height to sixty-eight (68) inches in height, in accordance with the drawings attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2. That the Meritorious Exception is approved subject to the following conditions:

-That the signs for "Bakery" and "Floral", which were requested by the applicant, are not approved, and can not be placed on the building.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby

repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense and that each day such violation shall continue to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 5. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provisions thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole.


