

**ORDINANCE NO. 097-025**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, CHANGING THE STREET NAME OF LINDBERG DRIVE TO LINDBERGH DRIVE;

WHEREAS, The Town had named streets around the airport area after famous pilots; and

WHEREAS, Lindberg Drive was to be named after the famous aviator Charles A. Lindbergh, but was inadvertently mis-spelled when the signs were ordered, and had been mis-spelled for many years; and

WHEREAS, many residents, business people, and visitors to the Town contacted the city and asked why the name was mis-spelled; and


WHEREAS, the Staff wrote letters to all business owners on the street and asked if they would agree to having the spelling corrected; and

WHEREAS, most business owners were agreeable to having the name of the street changed; now therefore, the name of Lindberg Drive shall be changed to Lindbergh Drive.
