ORDINANCE NO. 098-002

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 14, SIGNS, SECTION 46, MONUMENT SIGNS, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR A CHANGE IN THE REGULATIONS FOR MONUMENT SIGNS IN ORDER TO ALLOW FOR A PLASTIC-FACED MONUMENT SIGN PROVIDED THAT ONLY THE LETTERS, NUMBERS OR LOGO ELEMENTS EMIT LIGHT; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 14, Section 46, Monument Signs, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 14-46. Monument Signs.

Monument signs must be built on a monument base as opposed to a pole base with no separation between the base of the sign and natural grade. A monument sign contains only the name, logo, address, and product or service of the establishment. No advertising or promotional information is permitted thereon. Such signs may be single or double faced. Such signs with base shall not exceed six (6) feet in overall height above the natural or aberage grade and the actual sign face shall not exceed forty-eight (48) square feet in area per side. One monument per adjoining street will be allowed. Plastic faces may be used on monument signs provided only the letters, numbers or logo elements emit light. The monument sign shall be located on site and a minimum of twenty (20) feet from the back of the curb.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of Two

Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense and that each day such violation shall continue to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provisions thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole.
