

ORDINANCE NO. 098- 040

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON
AMENDING THE WATER AND WASTEWATER
RATES FOR COMMERCIAL AND RESIDENTIAL
CUSTOMERS; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL OF
ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES, AND SETTING
AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

Whereas, during development of the 1998-1999 it was determined the resources available to the Utility fund were sufficient for meeting operating expenditures, debt service, and capital requirements; and,

Whereas the revenues generated by increasing commercial and residential development has exceeded the forecasts of the 1996 Utility Rate Analysis; and,

Whereas the 1998-99 Town of Addison Annual Budget assumes a five percent decrease in water and sewer rates;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON.

I. Sewer Rates

That Chapter 18, Section 76 of the Town of Addison Code of Ordinances entitled "Sewage rates" shall be amended to read as follows:

"The customer classifications, minimum bills, and consumption charges shall be as follows:

Sewer Minimum Bills. Minimum monthly bills shall be applied to all customers based upon customer classification and shall include an allowance for volume based upon water consumed as follows:

<u>Customer Classification</u>	<u>Minimum Monthly Bill</u>	<u>Volume Included (Gallons)</u>
Single Family Residential	\$ 8.47	2,000
Multi-Family Residential	47.75	15,000
Municipal/Schools	62.92	20,000

Commercial Large (meter size equal to or greater than 2")	114.27	37,000
Commercial Small (meter size less than 2")	14.93	3,000
Industrial Large (meter size equal to or greater than 2")	244.33	80,000
Industrial Small (meter Size less than 2")	11.48	3,000
Hotel/Motel	244.33	80,000

Sewer Volume Rate. All volume which exceeds the amount allowed in the minimum bill shall be charged at a rate of \$3.03 per 1,000 gallons of water consumed for all customer classifications.

II. Water Rates

That Chapter 18, Section 77 of the Town of Addison Code of Ordinances entitled "Water rates" shall be amended to read as follows:

"The customer classifications, minimum bills, and consumption charges shall be as follows:

Water Minimum Bills. Minimum monthly bills shall be applied to all customers based upon customer classification and shall include an allowance for volume based upon water consumed as follows:

<u>Customer Classification</u>	<u>Minimum Monthly Bill</u>	<u>Volume Included (Gallons)</u>
Single Family Residential	\$ 7.36	2,000
Multi-Family Residential	44.23	15,000
Municipal/Schools	58.23	20,000
Commercial Large (meter size equal to or greater than 2")	107.00	37,000
Commercial Small (meter size less than 2")	10.41	3,000
Industrial Large (meter size equal to or greater than 2")	235.31	80,000
Industrial Small (meter size less than 2")	9.49	3,000

Hotel/Motel	235.31	80,000
Sprinkler Large (meter size equal to or greater than 2")	73.50	27,000
Sprinkler Small (meter size less than 2")	15.17	5,000
Fire Meters	24.05	8,000

Water Volume Rate. All volume which exceeds the amount allowed in the minimum bill shall be charged at a rate of \$1.43 per 1,000 gallons of water consumed for all customer classifications.


III. Repeal

All ordinances which conflict with have previously set water and wastewater rates, and which conflict with this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

IV. Effective Date

The effective date of this ordinance shall be for all water and sewer bills issued on or after November 1, 1998.
