ORDINANCE NO. 099-008

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS,
CHANGING THE BASIS FOR PAYING COUCNILMEMBERS,
AIRPORT BOARD MEMBERS, AND PLANNING AND ZONING
COMMISSIONERS; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE;
PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR A
SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Whereas Section 2.04 of the Addison City Charter provides that Councilmembers may be compensated, and

Whereas, past Councils have extended the compensation to Planning and Zoning Commissioners and Airport Board Members, and

Whereas, under current tax law, the Councilmembers, Boardmembers, and Commissioners are employees of the city, and are required to pay Social Security and medicare taxes, and

Whereas, the city would like to add these members to the payroll system so that they can be paid on a bi-weekly basis. This will allow them to be compensated more efficiently and in accordance with the federal regulations.

SECTION 2. Councilmembers, Planning and Zoning Commissioners, and Airport Board Members shall be compensated in accordance with the following schedule:

Councilmembers:

\$50.00 per bi-weekly pay period (\$50.00 x 26 = \$1300 per year) Planning and Zoning Commissioners and Airport Board Members

\$25.00 per bi-weekly pay period $($25.00 \times 26 = $650 \text{ per year})$

SECTION 3. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provisions thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity o this ordinance as a whole.
