

ORDINANCE NO. 099-034

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS AMENDING CHAPTER 78, TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY BY AMENDING SECTION 78-109 RELATING TO ONE-WAY STREETS AND TEMPORARILY REVERSING THE DIRECTION OF TRAVEL ON McENTIRE PLACE AS A EASTBOUND ONE-WAY TRAVELED STREET AS SET FORTH HEREIN; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

1. Amendments. Chapter 78, Traffic and Vehicles, of the Code of Ordinances of the City is hereby amended to reverse the direction of travel on McEntire Place to control traffic for the construction of the art piece in the center of the Addison Circle/Quorum Drive traffic circle. The direction of travel on McEntire Place is hereby amended to eastbound beginning September 20, 1999, to be in effect for a period of time up to 90 days, as determined by the Director of Public Works.

2. Severability. If any part or provision of this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance, and the City Council hereby declares it would have passed such remaining portions of this ordinance despite such invalidity, which remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

3. Savings, Repealer. This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all other ordinances of the City affecting vehicle operation and shall not repeal any of the provisions of those ordinances except in those instances where provisions of those ordinances are in direct conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance.

4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the Town of Addison.
