ORDINANCE NO. 099-038

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 14, SIGNS, SECTION 14-42, PREMISES SIGNS, SECTION 14-97, SIGNS ON TREES, POLES, ETC., AND SECTION 14-101, SIGNS IN RIGHTS-OF-WAY, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, SO AS TO GRANT A MERITORIOUS EXCEPTION TO THE CITY'S SIGN ORDINANCE TO ALLOW OFF-PREMISES SIGNS IN THE RIGHTS OF WAY; ON APPLICATION WITH POST PROPERTIES, LOCATED AT ADDISON CIRCLE, PHASES I AND II; PROVIDING FOR SPECIAL CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. In accordance with Sections 4-42, 14-97, and 14-101 of the Sign Ordinance a meritorious exception is hereby granted to Post Properties, located at Addison Circle, Phases I and II, to allow 12, off-premises, detached signs in the rightsof-way, to be located in Addison Circle, Phases I and II, in accordance with the drawings attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2. That the additional detached signs are approved subject to the following special conditions:

- Sign #4 is not approved.

- Sign placement is subject to a license agreement with the Town. The license agreement shall dictate how the signs shall be placed and mounted.

-The approval goes to these signs only. If Post Properties sells the project, the new owner must come back to the Council with another request for Meritorious Exception.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense and that each day such violation shall continue to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 6. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provisions thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole.
