ORDINANCE NO. 001-011

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN BY REPEALING AND DELETING IN ITS ENTIRETY ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 14 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO THE AIRPORT BOARD; AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ADDING A NEW ARTICLE II TO CHAPTER 14 RELATING TO AIRPORT ADVISORY COMMITTEES; AMENDING SECTION 14-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF "BOARD"; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

Section 1. Repeal. The Code of Ordinances ("Code") of the Town of Addison, Texas (the "City") is hereby amended by repealing and deleting in its entirety Article II, Chapter 14 of the Code entitled "Airport Board".

Section 2. Amendment. The Code is hereby amended as follows:

A. A new Article II of Chapter 14 is hereby added to the Code to read as follows:

"ARTICLE II. AIRPORT ADVISORY COMMITTEES

"Section 14-31. The City Council may, from time to time and in its sole discretion, create by motion or otherwise such Airport advisory committees as it may deem appropriate to address matters affecting Addison Airport. Such committees shall be advisory only, and any person appointed to any such committee shall serve at the pleasure of the City Council."

B. Division 2 ("Fuel Dispensing Permit") of Article III ("Municipal Airport") of Chapter 14 of the Code is hereby amended by amending Section 14-86 ("Definitions") by amending the definition of "Board" to read as follows:

"Board means the City Councilthe town airport board."

Section 3. Savings. This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all other ordinances of the City and shall not repeal any of the provisions of those ordinances except in those instances where the provisions of those Ordinances are in direct conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4 Severability. The sections, paragraphs, sentences, phrases, clauses and words of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, clause or word in this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance, and the City Council hereby declares that it would have passed such remaining portions of this Ordinance despite such invalidity, which remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its date of passage as provided by law.
