**ORDINANCE NO. 001-033**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS AMENDING CHAPTER 38 (FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN BY AMENDING ARTICLE III SECTION 38-54(C) (EMERGENCY AMBULANCE SERVICE); PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:**

**Section 1. Amendment.** The Code of Ordinances (“Code”) of the Town of Addison, Texas (the “City”) is hereby amended by amending Chapter 38 (“Emergency Services”) of the Code as follows:


A. Article III (“Emergency Ambulance Service”) of Chapter 38 is hereby amended so that it shall hereafter read as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

**Section 2. Savings.** This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all other ordinances of the City and shall not repeal any of the provisions of those ordinances except in those instances where the provisions of those Ordinances are in direct conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance.

**Section 3 Severability.** The sections, paragraphs, sentences, phrases, clauses and words of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, clause or word in this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance, and the City Council hereby declares that it would have passed such remaining portions of this Ordinance despite such invalidity, which remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its date of passage and publication as may be required by law.



## EXHIBIT A

### ARTICLE III. EMERGENCY SERVICES

#### Section 38-54. Emergency Ambulance Service.

- (c) *Fees for service:* For non-residents, the following fees shall be charged per trip, per person for transportation by ambulance to a hospital, doctor's office or other location for the provision of emergency medical aid: \$350 for basic life support service; \$400 for advanced life support service, level 1; \$525 for advanced life support service, level 2. For residents, the following fees shall be charged per trip, per person for transportation by ambulance to a hospital, doctor's office or other location for the provision of emergency medical aid: \$300 for basic life support service; \$350 for advanced life support service, level 1; \$475 for advanced life support service, level 2. In addition, a fee of \$5.00 per loaded transport mile will be assessed for transportation by ambulance to a hospital, doctor's office or other location for the provision of emergency medical aid. Such fees shall be paid by the person(s) receiving or contracting for the emergency ambulance service. In the case of service received by a minor, the parent or guardian shall be responsible for payment of the fee.

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
