ORDINANCE NO. 009-019

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, CANVASSING AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF (I) THE GENERAL ELECTION OF OFFICERS HELD ON MAY 9, 2009 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING ONE (1) MAYOR FOR A TWO (2) YEAR TERM OF OFFICE AND THREE (3) COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR TWO (2) YEAR TERMS OF OFFICE EACH, AND (II) A SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON MAY 9, 2009 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING ONE (1) COUNCIL MEMBER TO SERVE AN UNEXPIRED ONE (1) YEAR TERM OF OFFICE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the Town of Addison, Texas (the "City") heretofore ordered and called a general election to be held on the 9th day of May, 2009 within the City for the purpose of electing one (1) Mayor for a two (2) year term of office and three Council Members for two (2) year terms of office each, and ordered and called a special election to be held within the City on the 9th day of May, 2009 for the purpose of electing one (1) Council member to serve an unexpired one (1) year term of office (collectively, the "Elections"); and

WHEREAS, notice of the Elections was given pursuant to and in accordance with applicable law, and the Elections were duly and lawfully conducted and held on May 9, 2009, and the returns of the Elections have been delivered in accordance with law to the City Council as the canvassing authority for the Elections; and

WHEREAS, a quorum of the City Council as required by law met on May 18, 2009 for the purpose of canvassing the returns and declaring the results of the Elections as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

Section 1. The above and foregoing recitals to this Ordinance are true and correct and are incorporated herein and made a part of this Ordinance for all purposes.

Section 2. Canvass of General Election.

A. A tabulation of the returns of the general election of officers of the City held on May 9, 2009, called and ordered for the purpose of electing one (1) Mayor for a two (2) year term of office and three Council Members for two (2) year terms of office each, is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein and made a part hereof for all purposes. A summary of the said tabulation of returns for the general election set forth in the attached Exhibit A, showing the total votes received by each of the candidates, is as follows:

B. In accordance with the foregoing and pursuant to applicable law, including the Texas Election Code and the City's Home Rule Charter, the City Council finds, determines and declares the results of said general election to be that:

Joe Chow is elected to the office of Mayor of the City for a term of two (2) years;

and

Blake Clemens, Bianca Noble, and Don R. Daseke are each elected to the office of Council Member of the City for a term of (2) years.

Section 3. <u>Canvass of Special Election.</u>

A. A tabulation of the returns of the special election of the City held on May 9, 2009, called and ordered for the purpose of electing one (1) Council Member for a one (1) year unexpired term of office, is attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein and made a part hereof for all purposes. A summary of the said tabulation of returns for the special election set forth in the attached Exhibit B, showing the total votes received by each of the candidates, is as follows:

B. In accordance with the foregoing and pursuant to applicable law, including the Texas Election Code and the City's Home Rule Charter, the City Council finds, determines and declares the results of said special election to be that:

Kimberly Lay is elected to the office of Council Member of the City for an unexpired term of one (1) year.

Section 4. Severability. The sections, paragraphs, sentences, phrases, clauses and words of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, clause or word in this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional by the final, valid judgment or decree of a Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance, and the City Council hereby declares that it would have passed such remaining portions of this Ordinance despite such invalidity, which remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from Section 5. and after its passage and approval.
