

NOTICE OF PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OR ALTERATION

- 577.13 Construction or alteration requiring notice.**
- Except as provided in 577.15, each sponsor who proposes any of the following construction or alteration shall notify the Administrator in the form and manner prescribed in 577.17:
 - Any construction or alteration of more than 200 feet in height above the ground level.
 - Any construction or alteration of greater height than an existing structure located adjacent and parallel to the following streets:
 - 100 to 1 for a horizontal distance of 20,000 feet from the nearest point of the nearest runway of each airport specified in subparagraph (1).
 - 100 to 1 for a horizontal distance of 10,000 feet from the nearest point of the nearest runway of each airport specified in subparagraph (1).
 - 100 to 1 for a horizontal distance of 5,000 feet from the nearest point of the nearest runway and adjacent area of each airport specified in subparagraph (1) of this paragraph.
 - Any structure, building, or other structure with the specific volume of a height which, if adjacent to a runway 17 feet for an Interstate Highway that is part of the National System of Military and Domestic Highways, whose construction is required for a minimum of 17 feet vertical clearance, 15 feet for any other public roadway, or 10 feet for the height of the highest public utility structure, shall be constructed, altered, or repaired in a manner that would result in a net height of the highest public utility structure that would exceed a standard of subparagraph (1) or (2) of this paragraph.
 - When requested by the FAA, any construction or alteration that would be an obstruction approach area defined in the FAA standard governing instrument approach procedures shall be constructed, altered, or repaired in a manner that would not exceed a standard of subparagraph (1) or (2) of this paragraph.
 - Any construction or alteration on any of the following sections (including highways):
 - An airport that is available for public use and is listed in the Airport Directory of the current Aeronautical Information Manual or in either the Alaska or Pacific Aeronautical Guide and Chart Supplement.
 - An airport under construction, the design of a major or important part of which has been approved by the Administrator, and except for public use.
 - A runway, taxiway, or other structure that is used for the operation of aircraft that is operated by the FAA regional office at that airport.
 - Each sponsor who proposes construction or alteration that is the subject of a proposed notice to be received by the FAA regional office at that airport shall be notified by the FAA regional office at least 30 days before the start of the construction or alteration.
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- 577.15 Construction or alteration not requiring notice.**
- No person is required to notify the Administrator for any of the following construction or alteration:
 - Any object that would be shaded by existing structures of a permanent and substantial character, or by temporary or nonsubstantial structures, that are located within the boundaries of the proposed notice area.
 - Any antenna structure of 20 feet or less in height except one that would increase the height of another antenna structure.
 - Any air navigation facility, except visual approach or landing aid, that is located within the boundaries of the proposed notice area and is a type specified by the Administrator, or an appropriate military or civil authority, in the location and height of which it is used for its functional purpose.
 - Any construction or alteration for which notice is required by any other FAA regulation.
 - The FAA regional office may, at its discretion, require the sponsor to submit a notice to the Administrator for any of the following construction or alteration:
 - Any construction or alteration that would be an obstruction approach area defined in the FAA standard governing instrument approach procedures.
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 - Each sponsor who is required to notify the Administrator under 577.13 shall submit a notice to the Administrator in the form and manner prescribed in 577.17. The notice shall be submitted to the Administrator at least 30 days before the start of the construction or alteration.
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- 577.17 Form and time of notice.**
- Each sponsor who is required to notify the Administrator under 577.13 shall submit a notice to the Administrator in the form and manner prescribed in 577.17. The notice shall be submitted to the Administrator at least 30 days before the start of the construction or alteration.
