

ADDISON AIRPORT

NOTICE OF PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OR ALTERATION

- 577.13 Construction or alteration requiring notice.**
- (1) Except as provided in 577.15, each sponsor who proposes any of the following construction or alteration shall notify the Administrator in the form and manner prescribed in 577.17:
 - (2) Any construction or alteration of more than 200 feet in height above the ground level in the:
 - (3) Any construction or alteration of greater height than an existing structure situated adjacent and parallel to the following streets:
 - (4) Any construction or alteration of greater height than the nearest point of the nearest runway of each airport specified in subparagraph (3) of this paragraph within a horizontal distance of 20,000 feet from the nearest point of the nearest runway of each airport specified in subparagraph (3) of this paragraph within a horizontal distance of 5,000 feet from the nearest point of the nearest runway and adjacent area of each airport specified in subparagraph (3) of this paragraph.
 - (5) Any structure, building, or other structure within the flight envelope of a facility which, if adjacent to a runway 17 feet for an Instrument Runway that is part of the National System of Military and Transport Airports whose construction or alteration is proposed for a minimum of 17 feet vertical clearance, 15 feet for an other public runway, or 10 feet for the height of the highest public aircraft, would normally impede the flight envelope of the facility.
 - (6) Any construction or alteration of more than 200 feet in height above the ground level in the vicinity of any other runway or any other structure which would normally impede the flight envelope of the facility.
 - (7) Any construction or alteration which would result in a standard of minimum height of 100 feet in the vicinity of any other runway or any other structure which would normally impede the flight envelope of the facility.
- 577.15 Construction or alteration not requiring notice.**
- (1) No person is required to notify the Administrator for any of the following construction or alteration:
 - (2) Any object that would be shaded by existing structures of a permanent and substantial character, as determined by the Administrator, which would not be visible from the flight envelope of the facility.
 - (3) Any structure, building, or other structure which is situated beyond all approach paths that the structure is situated with no adverse effect on any navigation.
 - (4) Any structure, building, or other structure which is situated within the flight envelope of the facility and which is not visible from the flight envelope of the facility.
 - (5) Any structure, building, or other structure which is situated within the flight envelope of the facility and which is not visible from the flight envelope of the facility.

- 577.17 Form and time of notice.**
- (1) Each person who is required to notify the Administrator under 577.13 shall submit a notice of proposed construction or alteration to the Chief Air Traffic Division, FAA Regional Office having jurisdiction over the area within which the construction or alteration will be located. Copies of FAA Form 7460-1 may be obtained from the headquarters of the Federal Aviation Administration or the Regional Office.
 - (2) The notice required under 577.13 (1) through (4) must be submitted in at least 30 days before the start of the following construction or alteration to be filed:
 - (3) The date an application for a construction permit is to be filed. However, a notice related to proposed construction or alteration that is subject to the licensing requirements of the Federal Communications Act may be filed to the FAA at the same time as the application for construction permit with the Federal Communications Commission, if at all, before that filing.
 - (4) A proposed structure or an alteration to an existing structure that exceeds 200 feet in height above the ground will be presumed to be a hazard to air navigation and to result in an inefficient utilization of airspace and the sponsor shall be required to file a hazard assessment with the notice of proposed construction or alteration. 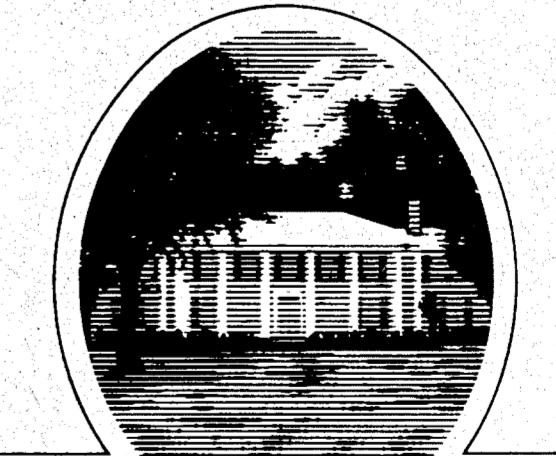
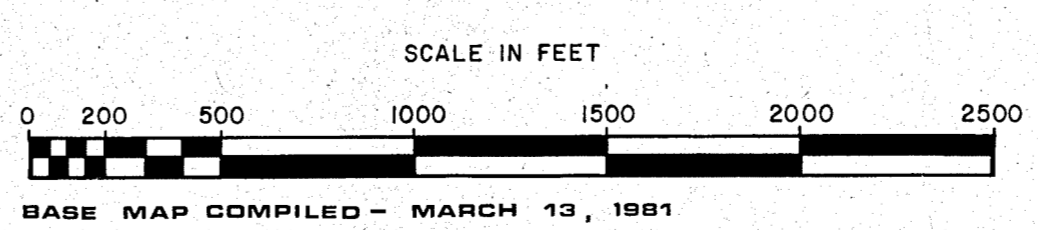
