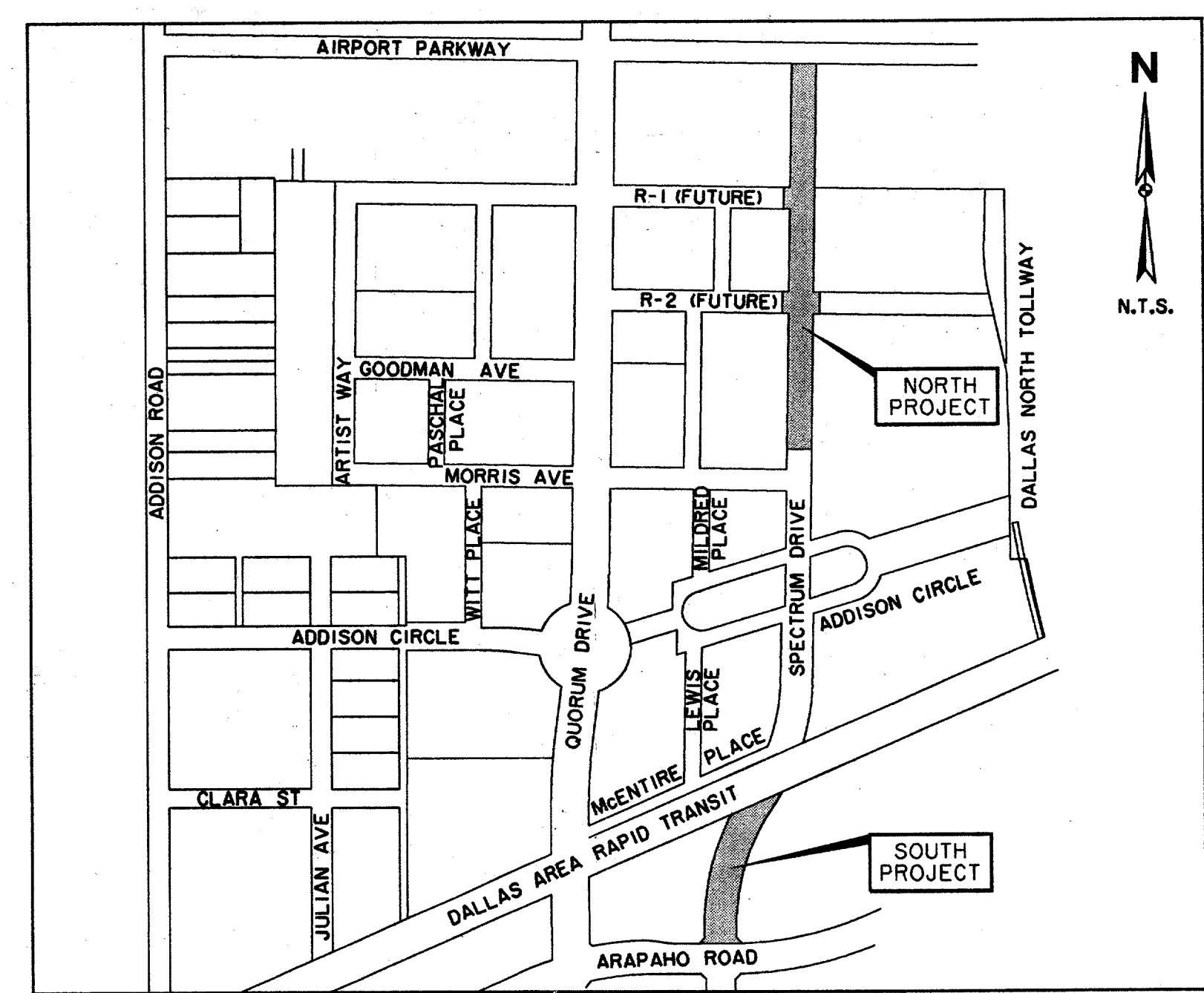

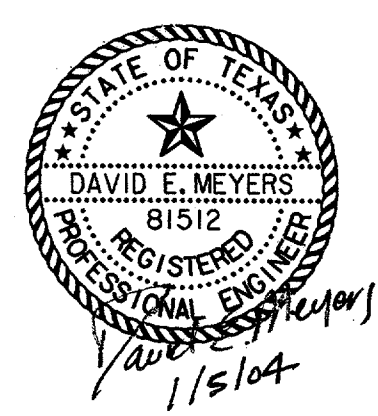
LOCATION MAP

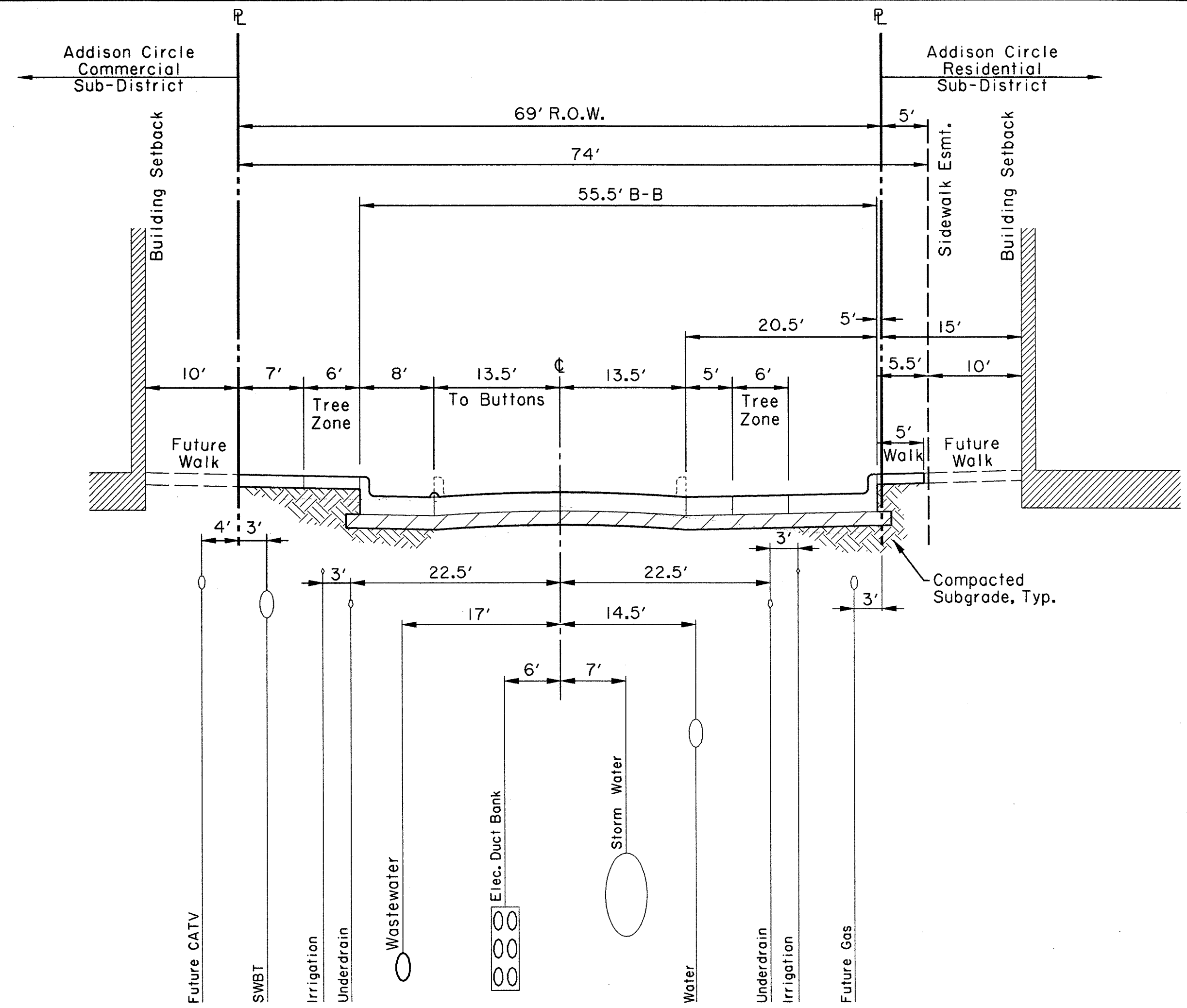

**BARRIER FREE RAMP
GENERAL NOTES**

1. MAXIMUM RUNNING SLOPE ON BARRIER FREE RAMPS MUST NOT EXCEED 1" PER FOOT @ ANY LOCATION.
2. DESIGNS SHOWN ARE FOR 6" CURBS. FOR CURBS WITH HEIGHT GREATER THAN 6" DIMENSIONS MUST BE INCREASED PROPORTIONATELY.
3. STREETS ON STEEP GRADE WILL REQUIRE LONGER TRANSITION ON UPGRADE SIDE.
4. LOCATION OF BARRIER FREE RAMP MAY BE SHIFTED TO CLEAR OBSTRUCTIONS.
5. CONC. TO HAVE MINIMUM 3000 PSI COMPRESSIVE STRENGTH @ 28 DAYS.
6. REINFORCEMENT TO BE #3 DEFORMED BARS @ 18" O.C.E.W. & SUPPORTED BY APPROVED BAR CHAIRS ON 3'-0" CENTERS.

NOTES:

1. BACKFILL MATERIAL IS NOT A SEPARATE PAY ITEM. MATERIAL ACQUIRED FROM EXCAVATION MAY BE USED IF APPROVED BY ENGINEER.
2. PAY LINE FOR UNCLASSIFIED STREET EXCAVATION IS TO THE TOE OF SLOPE IN FILL SECTIONS & TOP OF SLOPE IN CUT SECTIONS.
3. SAWED DUMMY JOINTS SHALL BE @ 12'-15' INTERVALS.
4. PROFILE GRADES SHOWN ON THE PAVING PLAN & PROFILE SHEETS ARE TOP OF CURB @ BACK OF CURB FOR A NORMAL ROADWAY CROSS-SECTION AS INDICATED ON THE TYPICAL SECTIONS BY "PROFILE T.C.",
5. CROSS SLOPES ON SIDEWALKS SHALL NOT EXCEED A 2% GRADE AND LONGITUDINAL SLOPES SHALL NOT EXCEED A 5% GRADE EXCEPT WHERE STREET GRADES REQUIRE A STEEPER GRADE. SLOPES IN EXCESS OF THE ABOVE NOTED MAXIMUMS WILL BE SUBJECT TO REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT AS DIRECTED BY THE ACCESSIBILITY REVIEWER.
6. ALL GRASSED AREAS SHALL BE WATERED UNTIL WELL ESTABLISHED. USE TEMPORARY IRRIGATION SYSTEM.
7. ALL SWEEPING SHALL BE VACUUM TYPE.

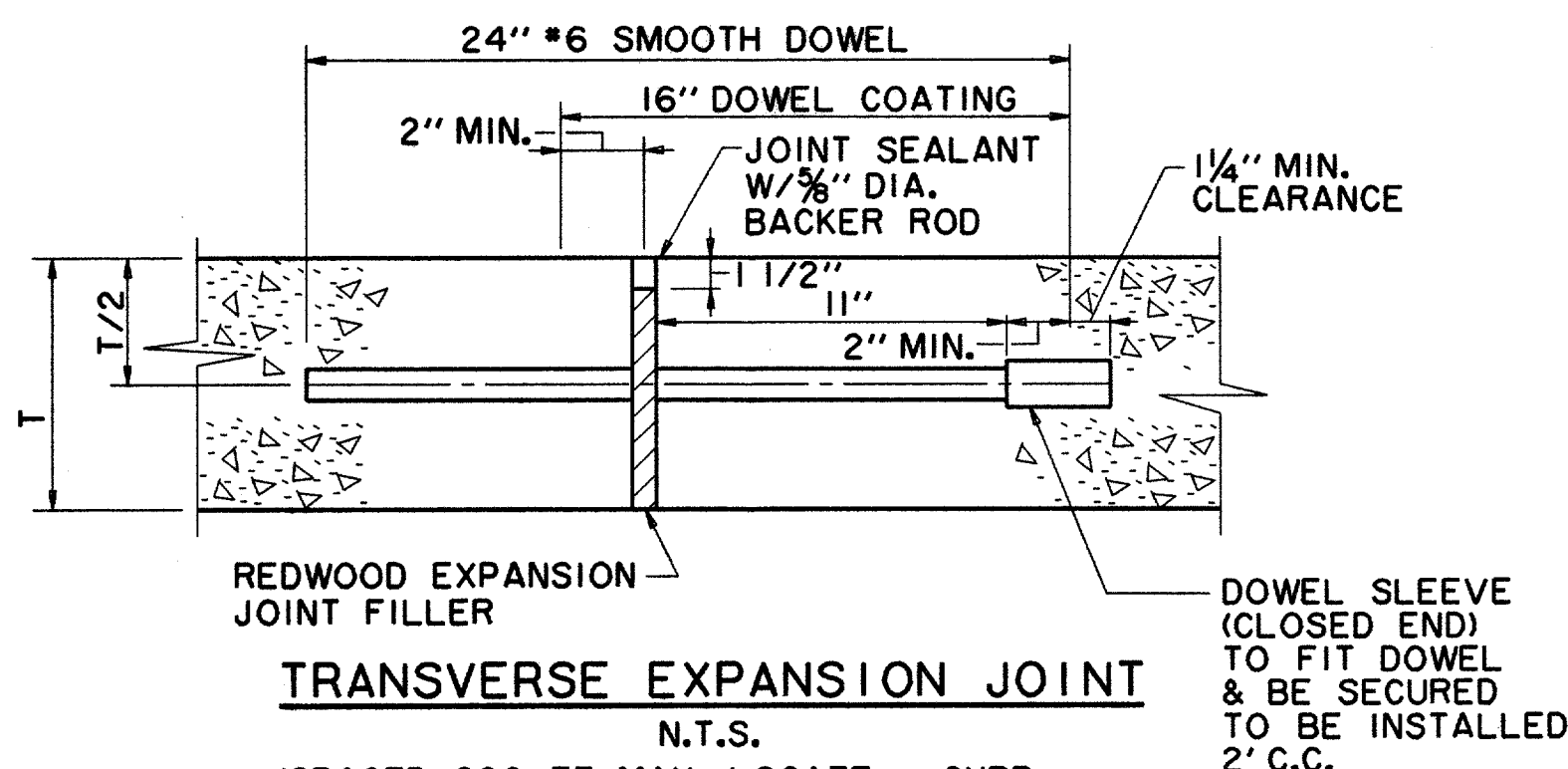

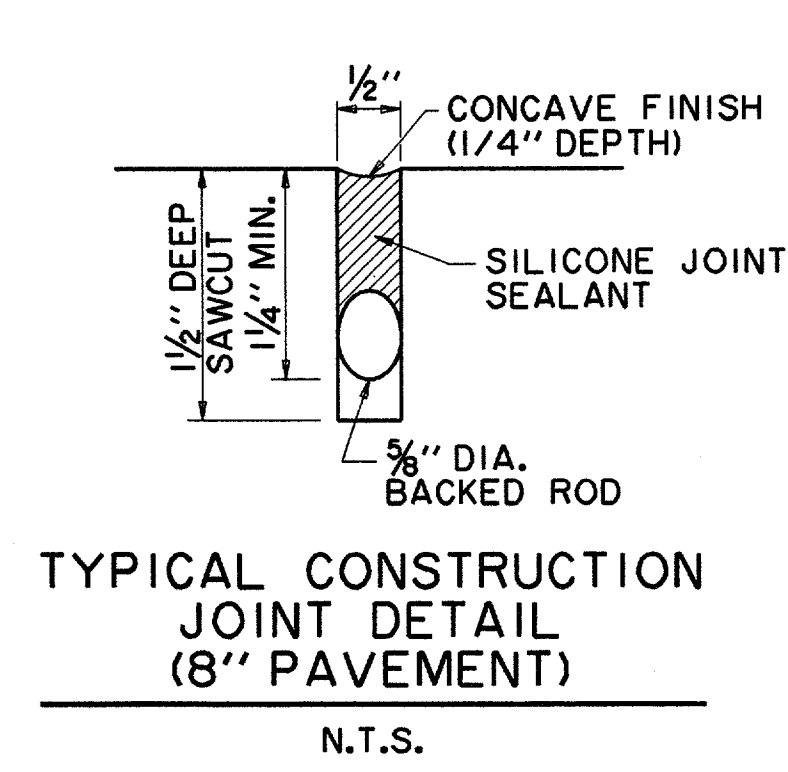

- UNLESS SPECIFICALLY STATED OTHERWISE IN PLANS OR CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, THE CONTROLLING SPECIFICATIONS FOR ALL WORK WITHIN PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY AND EASEMENTS SHALL BE THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION, THIRD EDITION 1998, AS AMENDED BY THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS ("STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS"), COPIES OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS MAY BE PURCHASED BY MAIL OR OVER THE COUNTER FROM THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS, 616 SIX FLAGS DRIVE, P.O. BOX DRAWER COG, ARLINGTON, TEXAS 76005-5888, PHONE METRO 817/640-3300. BULK DISCOUNTS ARE AVAILABLE. THIS DOCUMENT IS COPYRIGHTED.
- THE PAVING AREAS WILL BE GRADED TO +/- .10' OF FINISHED SUBGRADE ELEVATIONS. SIDEWALK AREAS WILL BE GRADED TO +/- .10' OF FINISHED PAVEMENT ELEVATION.
- ALL TRAFFIC CONTROL NECESSARY FOR THE WORK SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE SUCCESSFUL CONTRACTOR. ALL BARRICADES, WARNING SIGNS, LIGHTS, DEVICES, ETC. FOR THE GUIDANCE AND PROTECTION OF TRAFFIC AND PEDESTRIANS MUST CONFORM TO THE INSTALLATIONS SHOWN IN THE LATEST ISSUE OF THE "TEXAS MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES FOR STREETS AND HIGHWAYS (MUTCD)", AS CURRENTLY AMENDED, TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.
- ALL FILL SHALL BE PLACED IN MAXIMUM 8-INCH LIFTS COMPACTED TO 95% OF STANDARD PROCTOR DENSITY BETWEEN 0% AND +3% OF OPTIMUM MOISTURE CONTENT.
- ALL TREES, STUMPS, BRUSH, GRASSES AND SURFACE ORGANICS WITHIN PROPOSED RIGHT-OF-WAY ARE TO BE REMOVED AND PROPERLY DISPOSED OF OFF-SITE. TREE REMOVAL PERMITS, IF REQUIRED, WILL BE OBTAINED BY THE OWNER.
- EXISTING UTILITY POLES, IF ANY, WILL BE REMOVED OR RELOCATED BY THE UTILITY COMPANIES THROUGH COORDINATION BY THE OWNER. CONTRACTOR SHALL BRING TO THE OWNER'S ATTENTION ANY FACILITIES THAT APPEAR TO BE IN CONFLICT SO THAT THE OWNER HAS SUFFICIENT TIME TO ACCOMPLISH THE NECESSARY RELOCATIONS.
- WHERE DEEP VERTICAL EXCAVATIONS (IN EXCESS OF 3 FEET) ARE INDICATED, CUTS SHALL BE LAID BACK AT A STABLE SLOPE (ON OWNER'S PROPERTY). BACKFILL MATERIAL SHALL BE STOCKPILED ON-SITE AT THE DIRECTION OF THE OWNER.
- ALL REINFORCING STEEL AND DOWEL BARS IN PAVEMENT SHALL BE SUPPORTED AND MAINTAINED AT THE CORRECT CLEARANCES BY THE USE OF BAR CHAIRS OR OTHER APPROVED SUPPORT. INSERTION OF RE-BAR INTO "GREEN" CONCRETE IS PROHIBITED.
- THE USE OF WOOD FORMS FOR PAVEMENT CONSTRUCTION WILL BE PERMITTED.
- BARRIER-FREE RAMPS WILL BE BUILT ON THIS PROJECT. LOCATIONS MAY BE ADJUSTED AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER TO CLEAR OBSTRUCTIONS.
- VARIABLE HEIGHT CURB AT INTERSECTIONS AND SLOPING CURBS AT DRIVES SHALL BE BUILT TO MATCH BARRIER-FREE RAMPS PER PLANS. NO SEPARATE PAY ITEMS ARE APPROVED.
- TWO-WAY TRAFFIC MUST BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES ON EXISTING PUBLIC STREETS ADJACENT TO THIS PROJECT UNLESS SPECIFIED OTHERWISE IN THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS. THE TRAVELWAY WIDTH SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN 11 FEET.
- SEE TYPICAL SECTIONS SHEET FOR ADDITIONAL MATERIAL SPECIFICATIONS.
- ALL CURBS SHALL BE PLACED INTEGRAL WITH PAVEMENT.
- CURBS SHALL MEET THE SAME COMPRESSIVE STRENGTH AS SPECIFIED FOR THE CONCRETE PAVEMENT.
- BAR LAPS SHALL BE 30 DIAMETERS.
- FINISH SHALL BE TRANSVERSE WITH TRAFFIC LANES AND SHALL BE STEEL TINED BROOM FINISH.

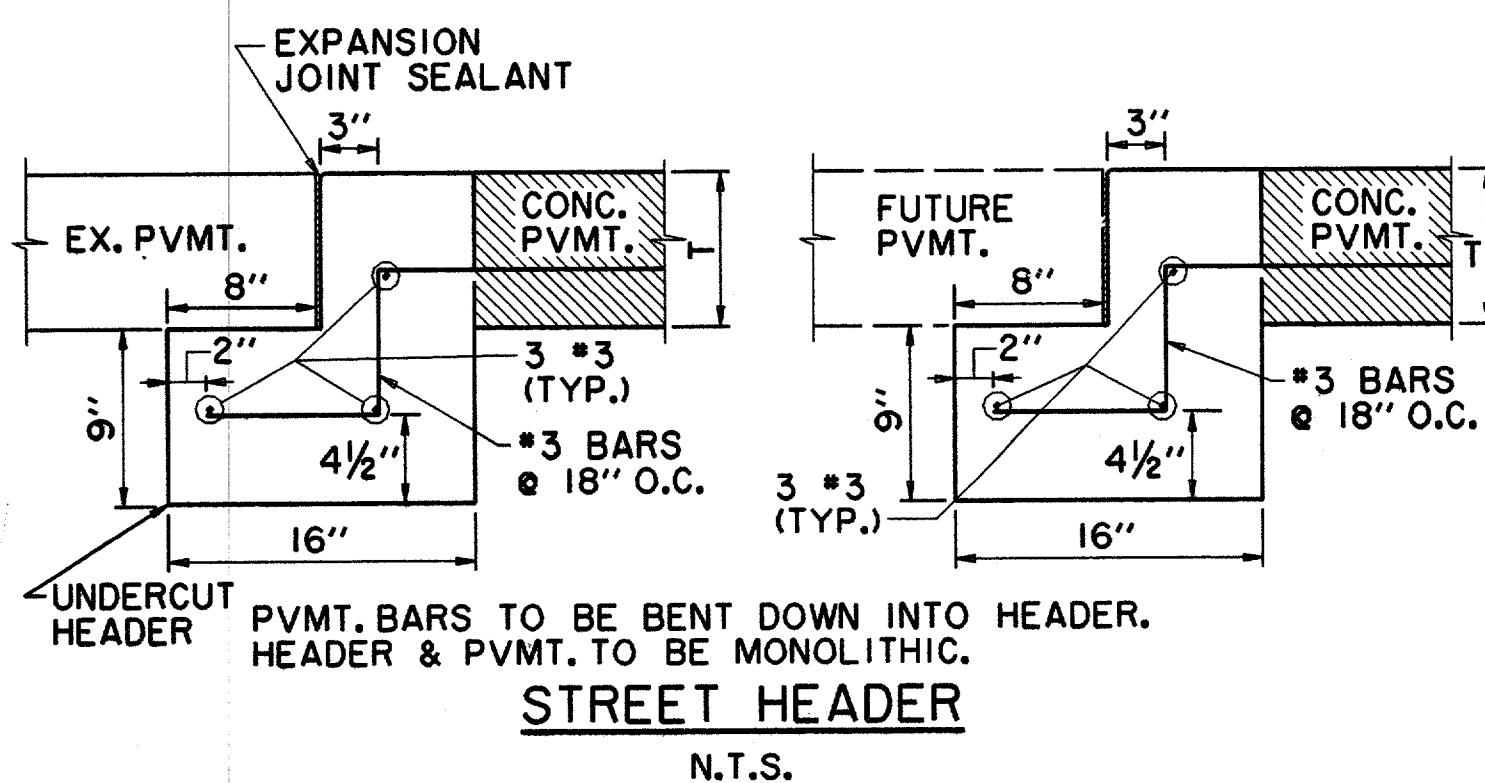
VEHICULAR BRICK INSTALLATION IN VEHICULAR AREAS

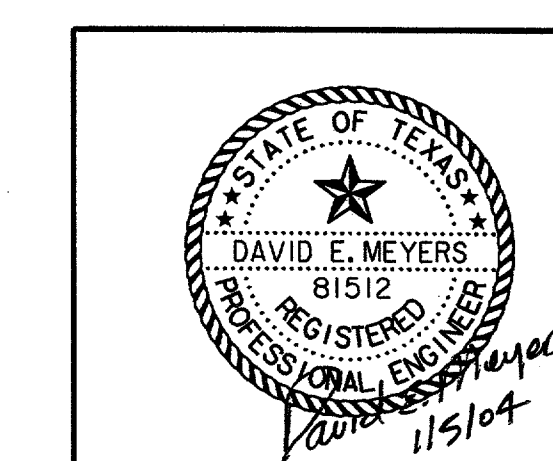


SECTION THRU CURB AT DROP SLAB

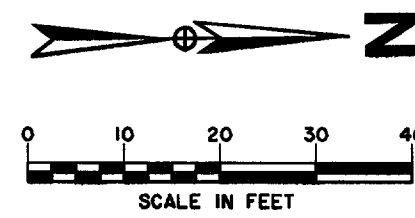

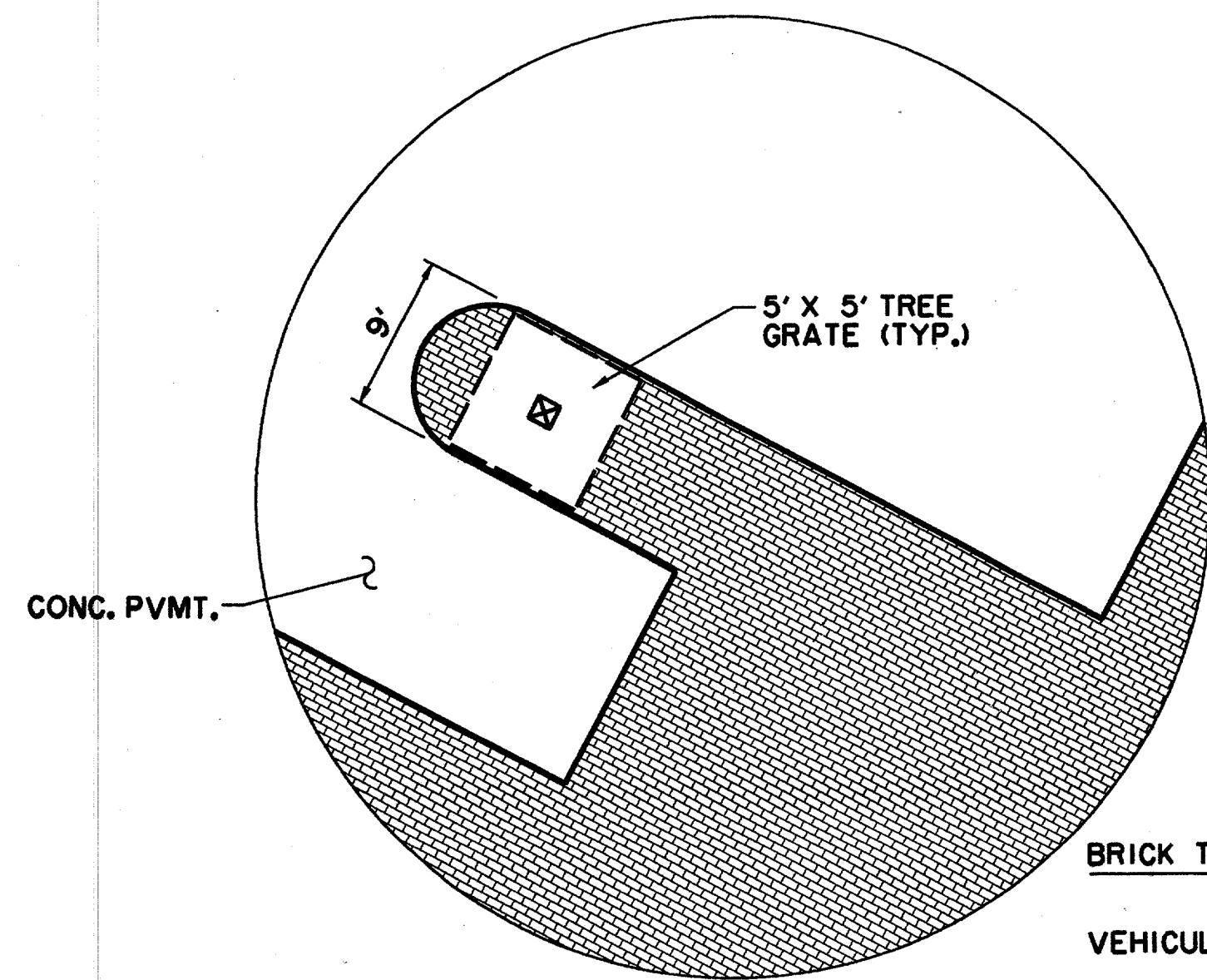

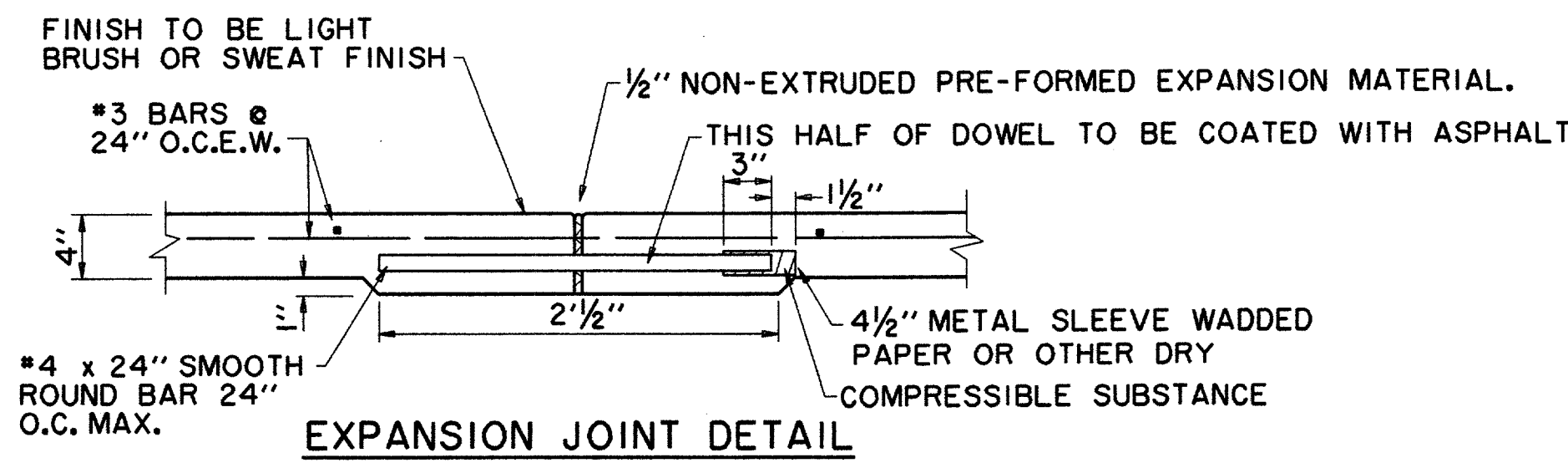

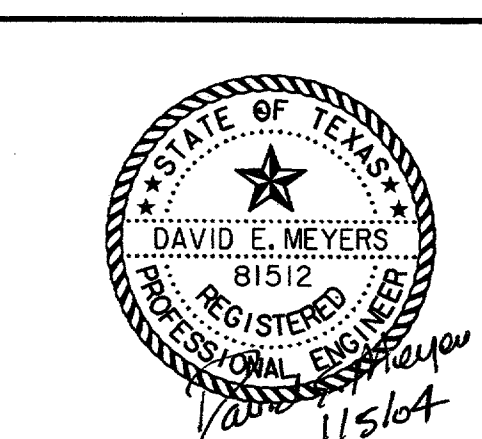


TREE PIT PLAN (SPECTRUM DRIVE)

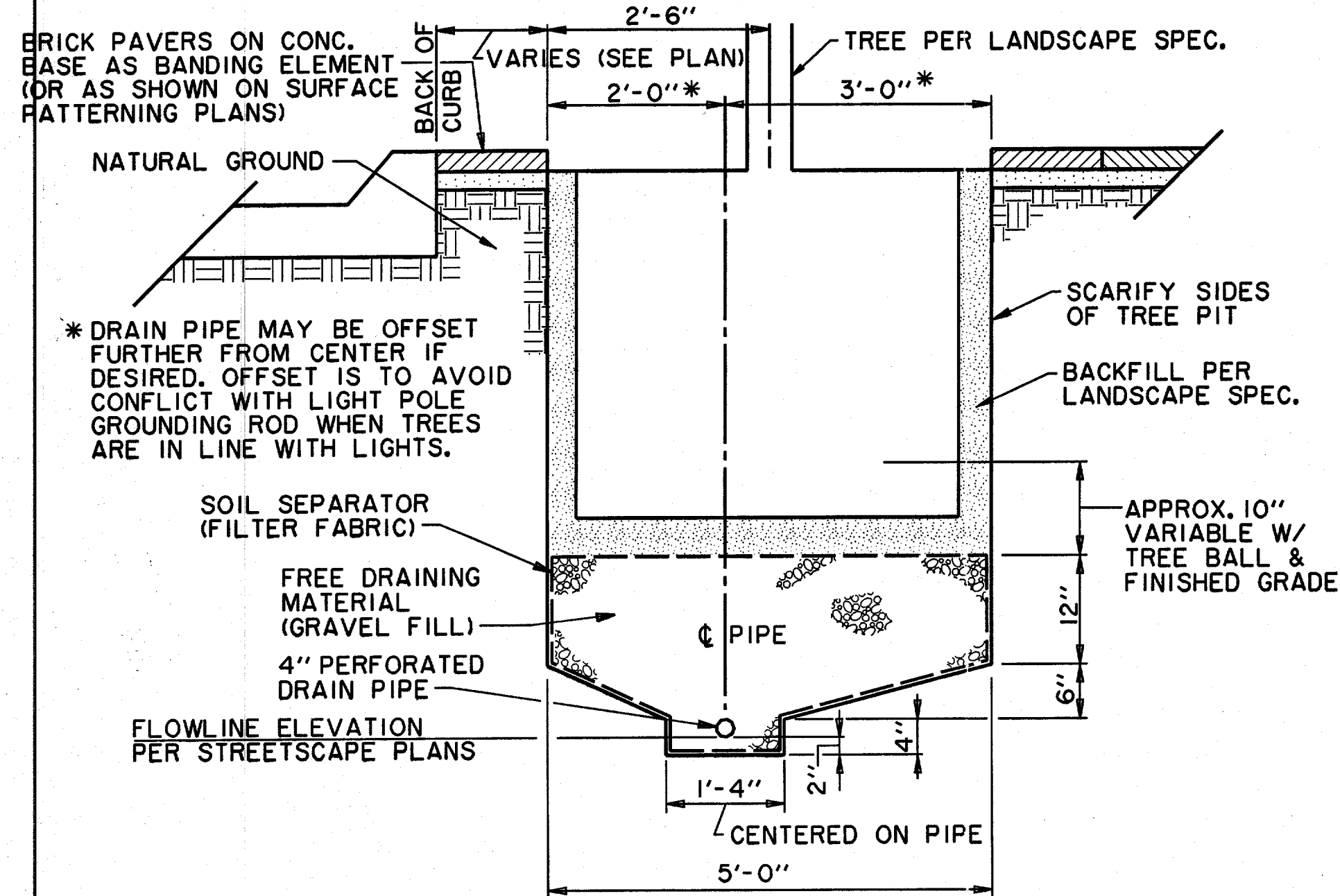

GENERAL NOTES CONCRETE SUBBASE FOR SIDEWALKS

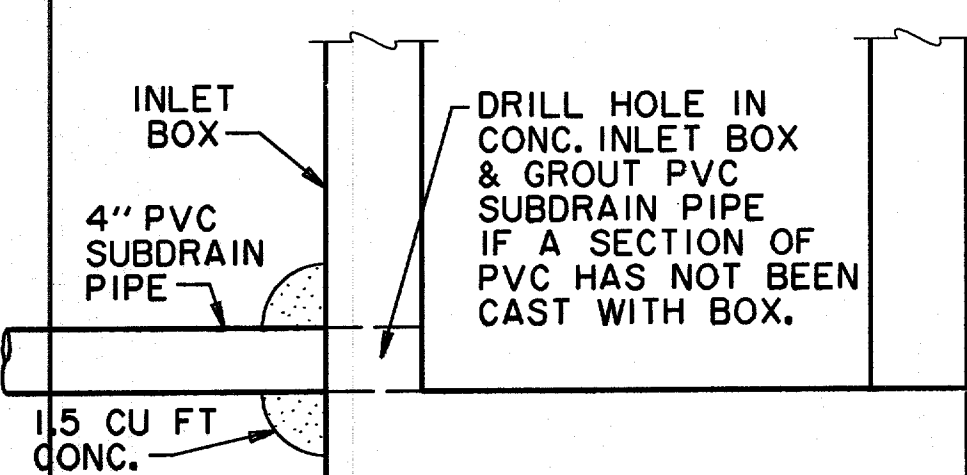
1. REINFORCED CONCRETE SIDEWALK SHALL BE A MINIMUM OF FOUR (4) INCHES THICK AND SHALL BE 3000 PSI AT 28 DAYS (5 SACK MIX) UNLESS NOTED OTHERWISE.
2. A 1/4" CHAMFER OR 1/4" RADIUS WILL BE REQUIRED ON ALL EXPOSED EDGES OF CONCRETE SIDEWALK.
3. ALL BAR DIMENSIONS ARE GIVEN AS CENTER TO CENTER OF BARS AND ARE LOCATED AS SHOWN.
4. ALL REINFORCING STEEL SHALL BE NO. 3 ON 18" CENTERS LONGITUDINALLY, 18" CENTERS TRANSVERSELY AND SHALL CONFORM TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF ASTM A-615, GRADE 60.
5. 1" THICK MIN. FINE WASHED SAND CUSHION SHALL BE FREE FROM ORGANIC MATERIALS OR CLAYS AND SHALL BE USED FOR GRADE ADJUSTMENT.
6. SUBGRADE SHALL BE COMPACTED TO A DENSITY NOT LESS THAN 95% OF STANDARD PROCTOR DENSITY AT 0 TO +3% OF OPTIMUM MOISTURE.
7. TOOLED JOINTS (CONTRACTION JOINTS) SHALL BE ON FIVE (5) FOOT CENTERS AND SHALL BE ROUND ONE-FOURTH (1/4) INCH RADIUS.
8. A ONE-HALF (1/2) INCH EXPANSION JOINT SHALL BE PLACED EVERY FORTY (40) FEET, AND WHERE WORKS ABUT OLD WORK, OR WHERE NEW WORK IS CONSTRUCTED ADJACENT TO OTHER CONCRETE.
9. EXPOSED SIDEWALKS SHALL BE FINISHED BY LIGHTLY BROOMING SURFACE TRANSVERSELY TO DIRECTION OF MAIN TRAFFIC.



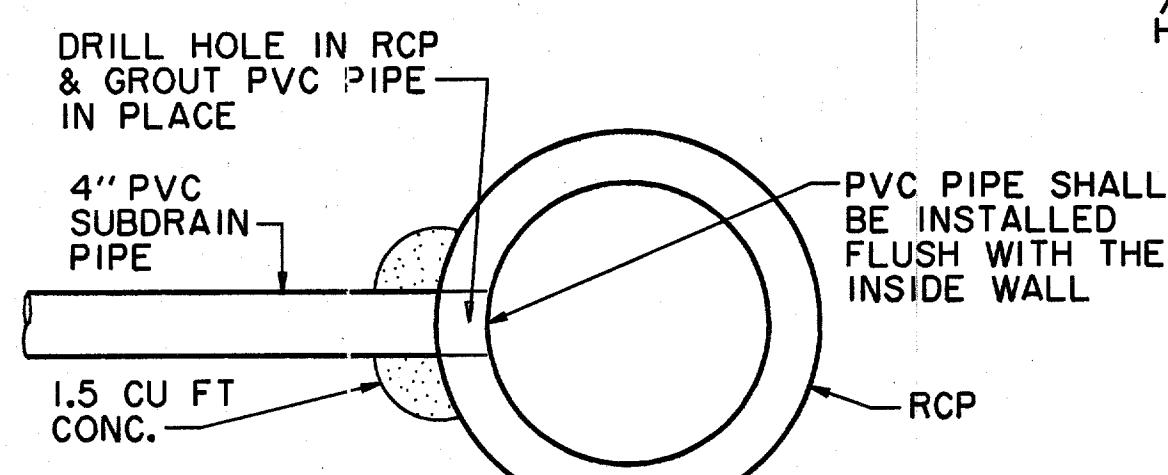

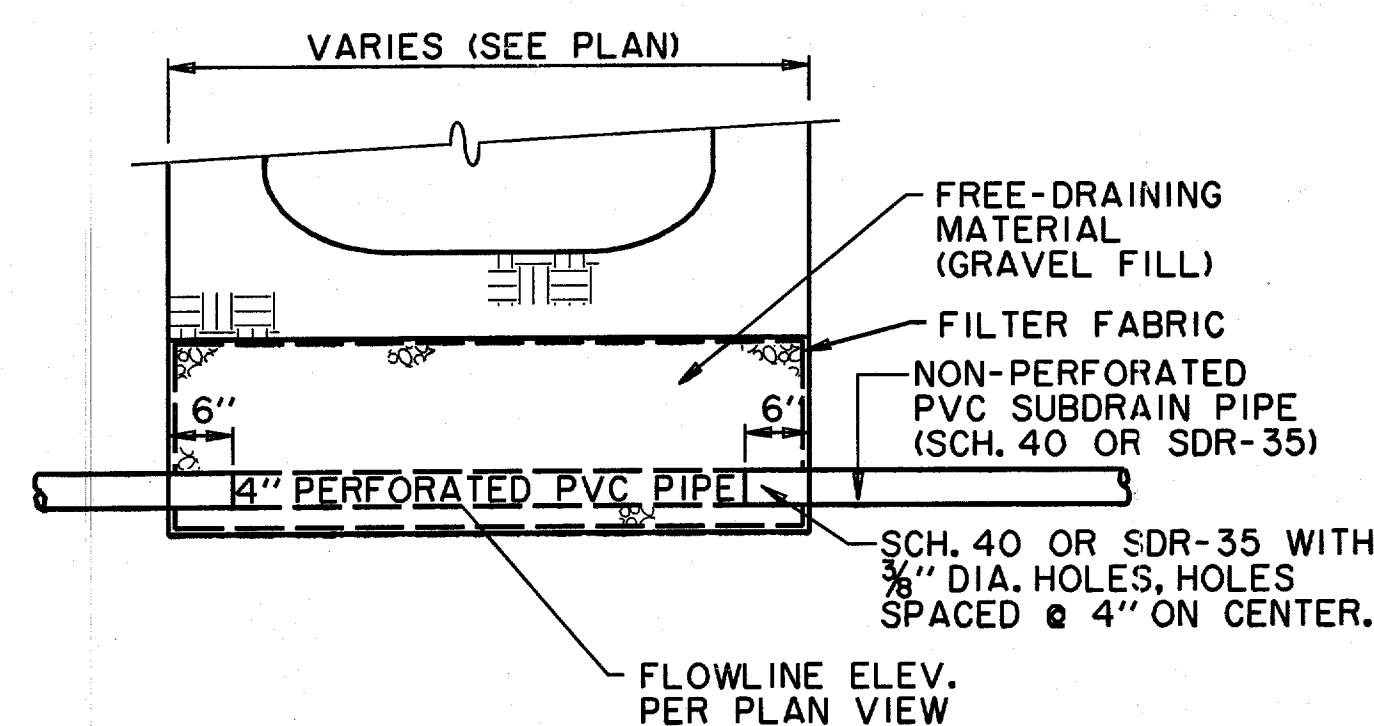
SUBSURFACE DRAIN SYSTEM DETAIL

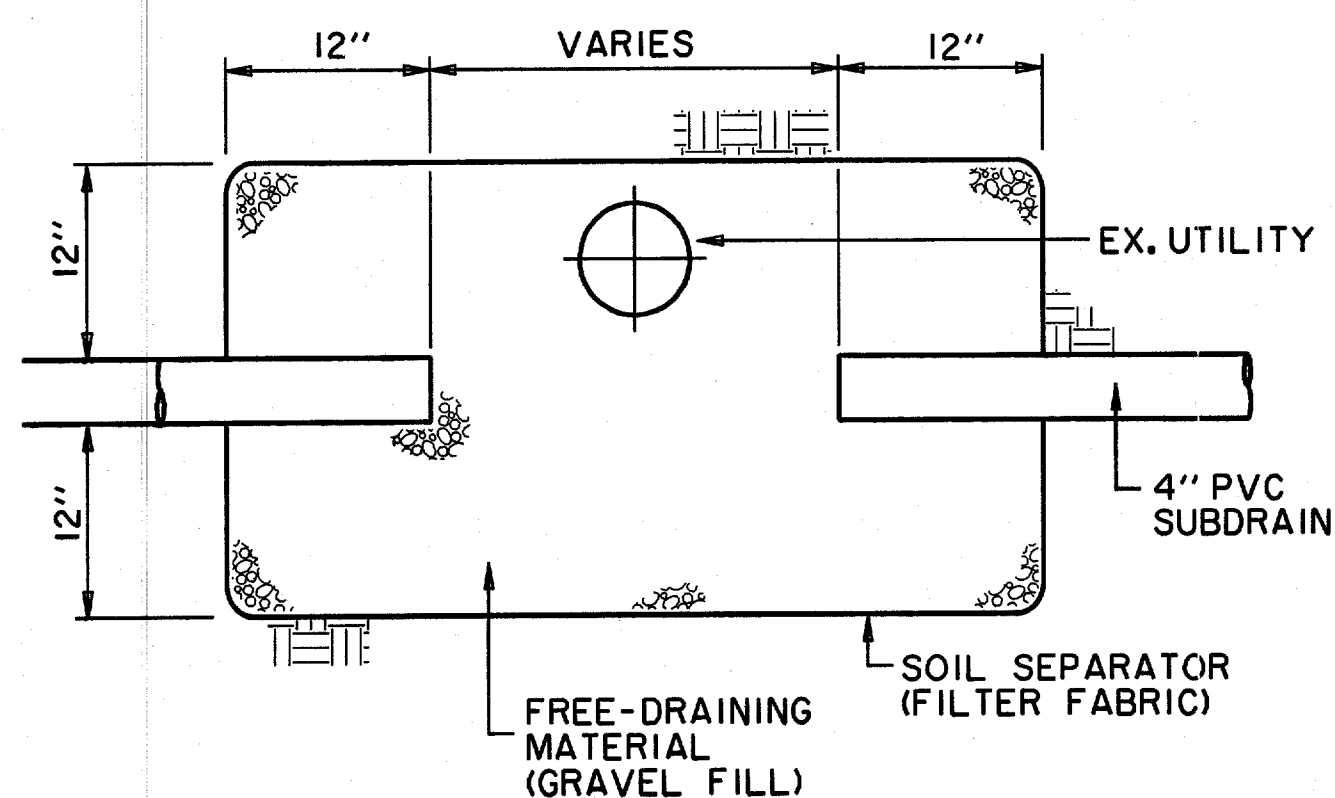

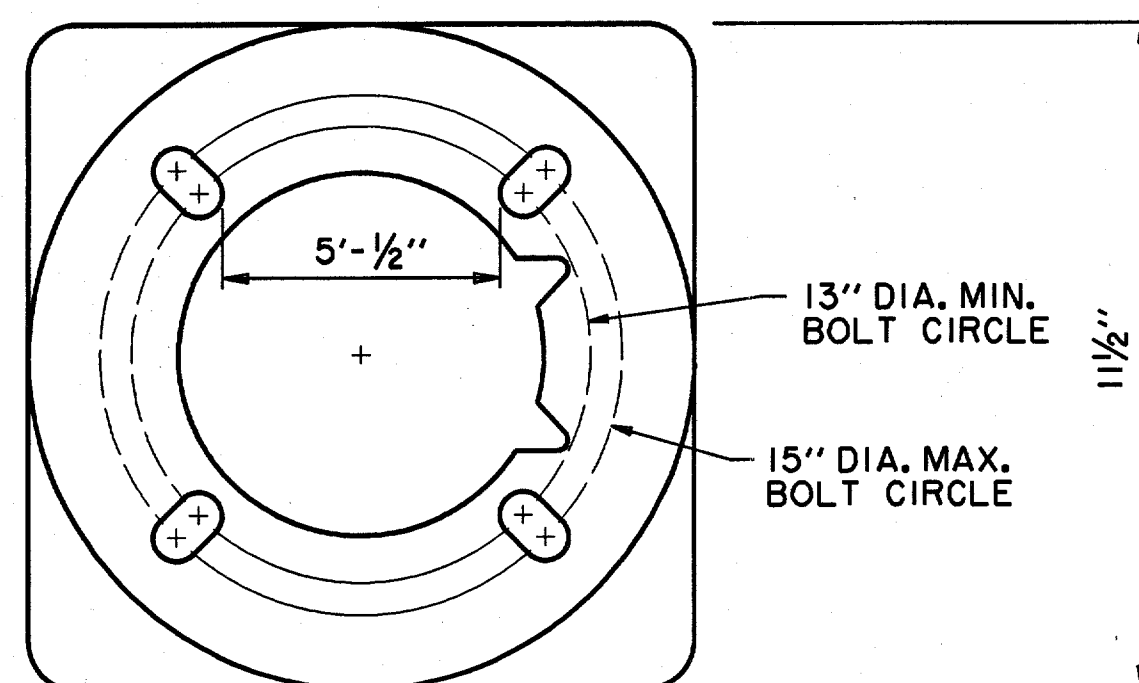


SUBSURFACE DRAIN SYSTEM DETAIL

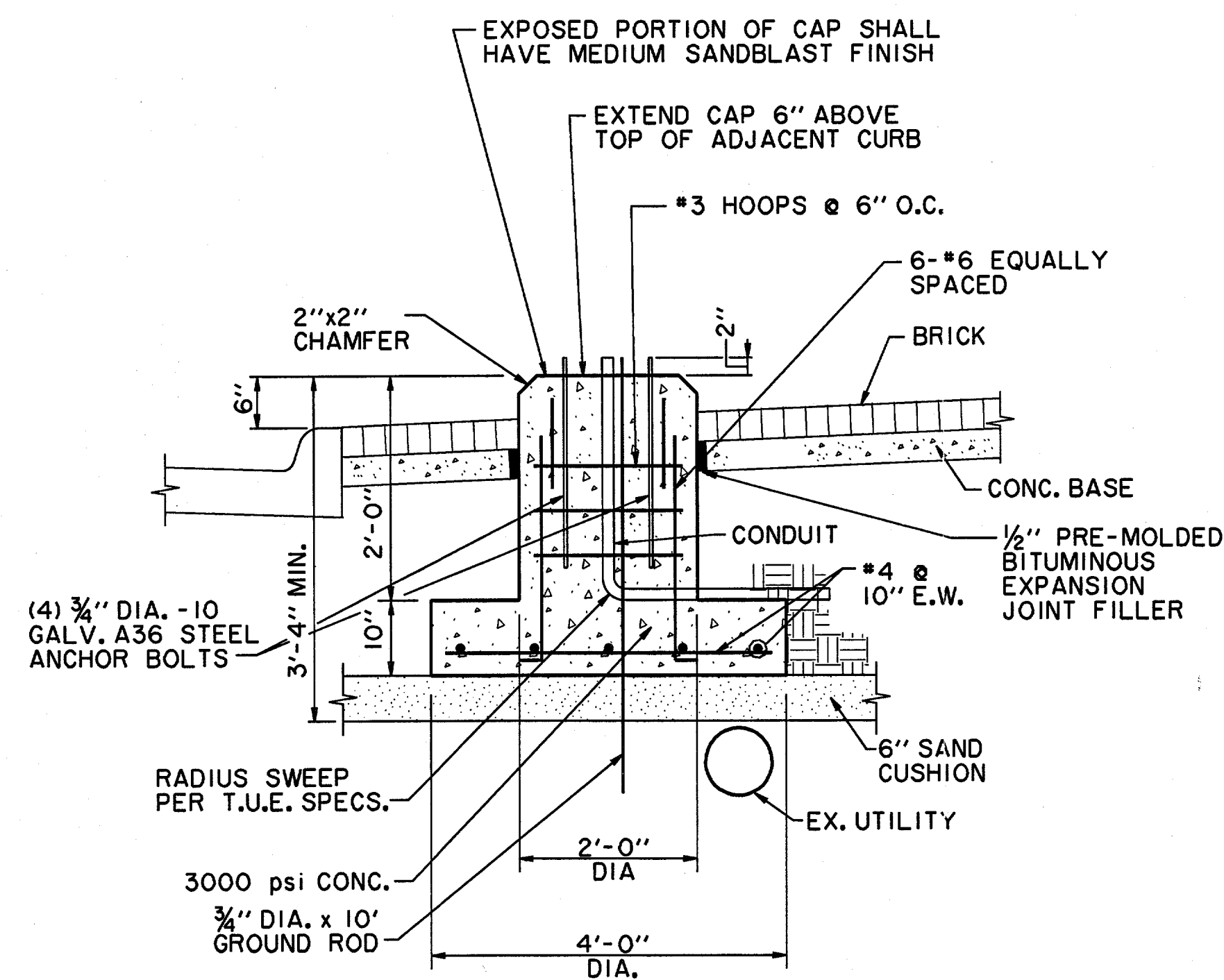
BOLT PROJECTION DETAIL (PEDESTRIAN)

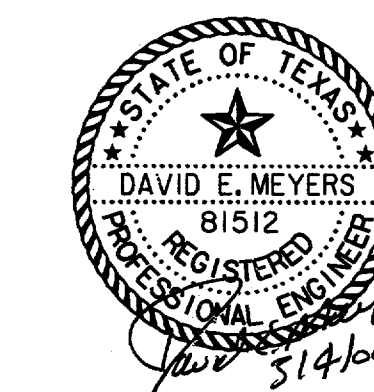

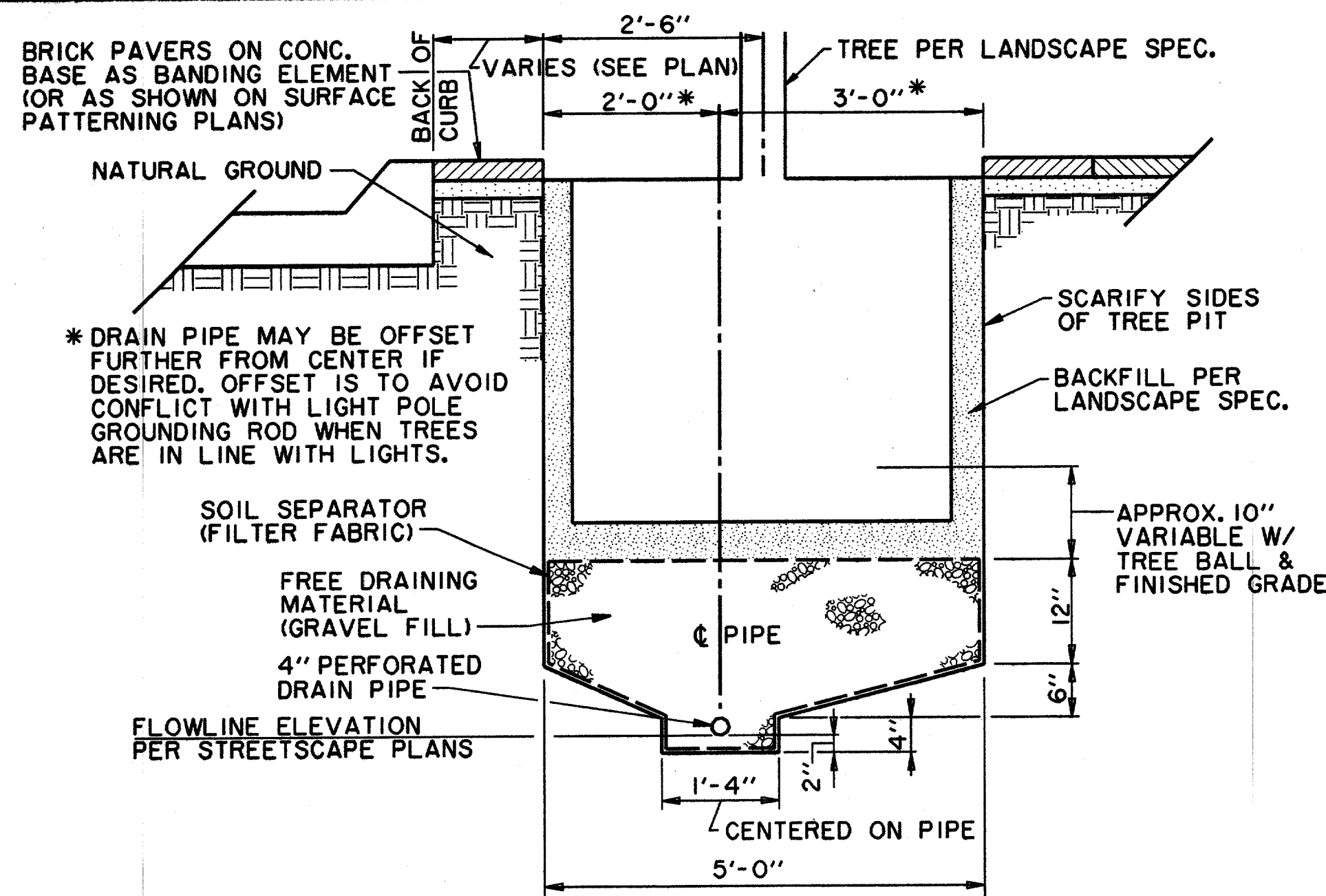
1. THE PEDESTRIAN STREET LIGHTING FOR THIS PROJECT WILL CONSIST OF INSTALLATION OF 2" PVC CONDUIT, LIGHT POLE BASES, PULL BOXES (HANDHOLES) LIGHT POLES, LUMINAIRES, WIRING & CONNECTION TO POWER SOURCE AS A COMPLETE SYSTEM PER DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS.

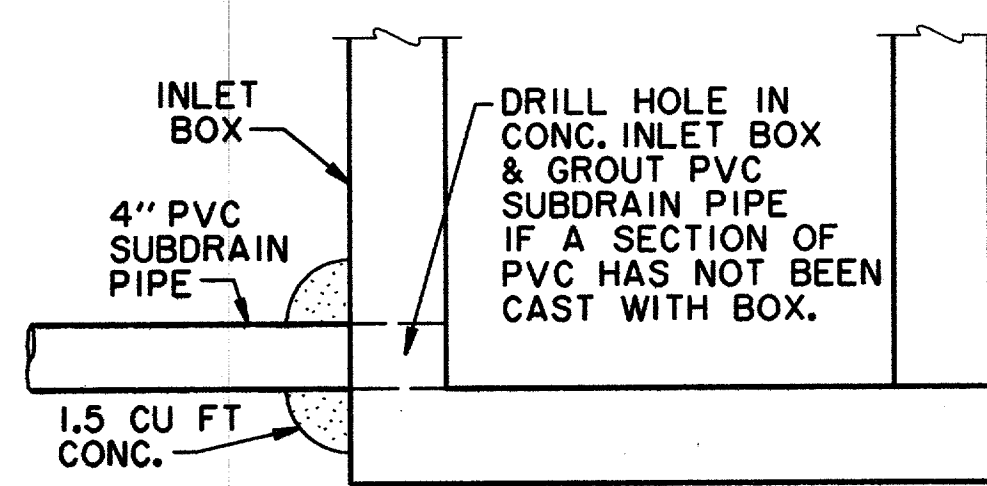

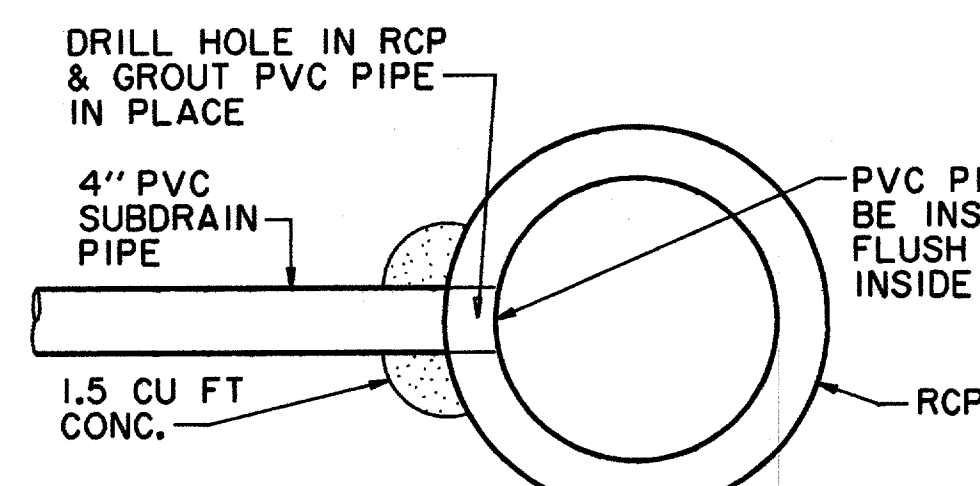
SUBSURFACE DRAIN SYSTEM DETAIL

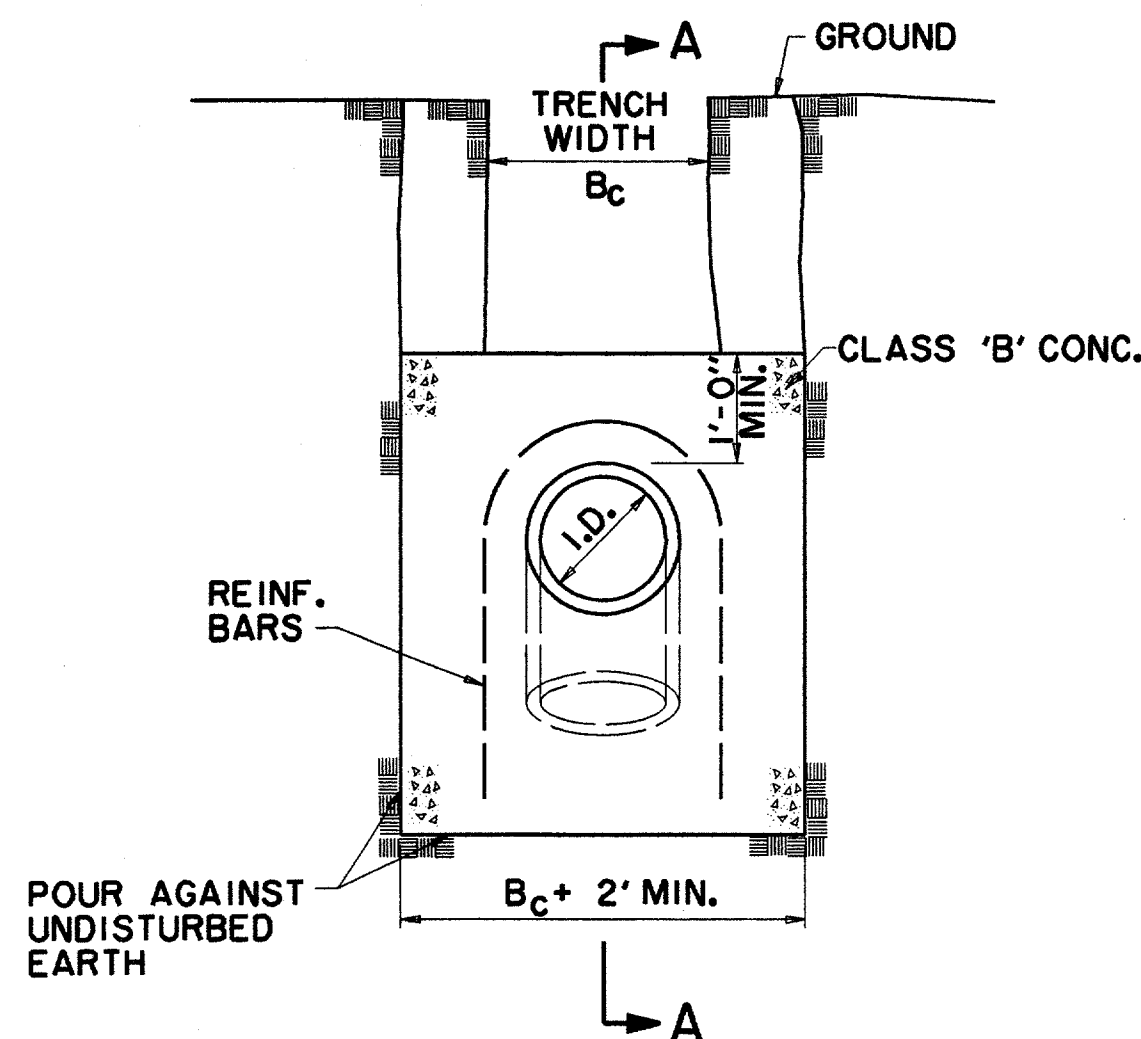


PLAN OF PLUG THRUST BLOCK

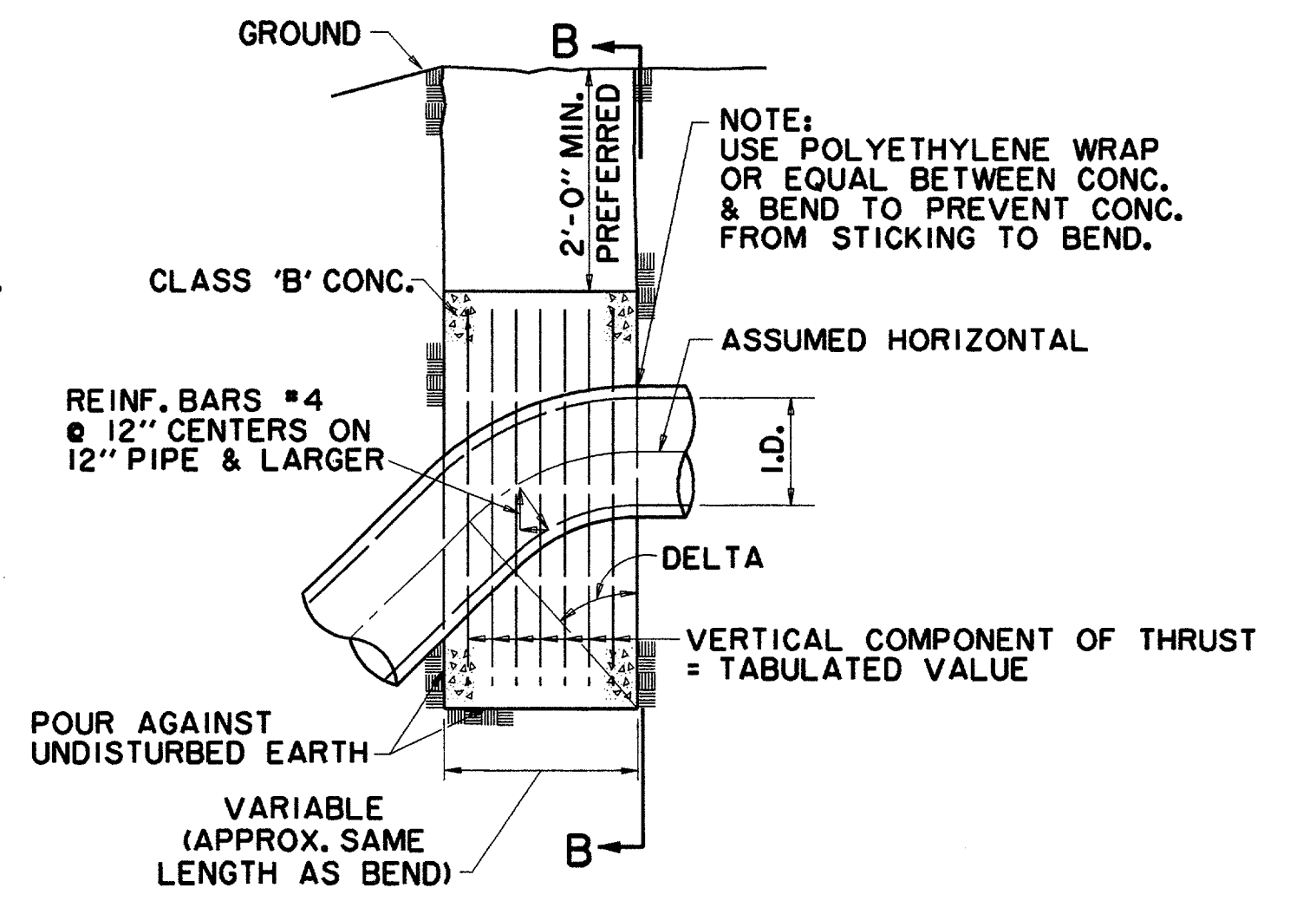


PLAN OF TEE THRUST BLOCK

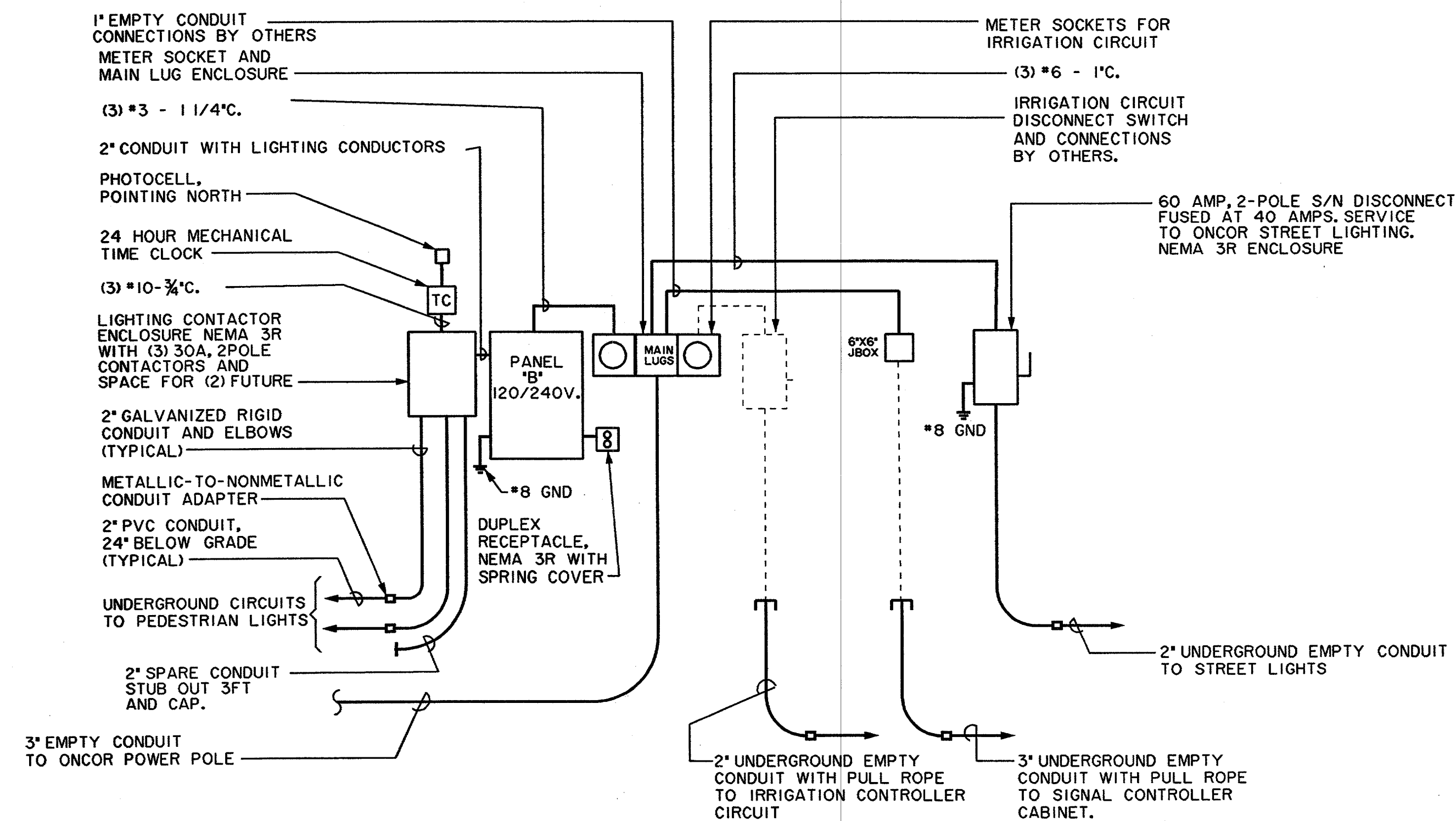

CONNECTIONS AT SIGNAL CONTROLLERS



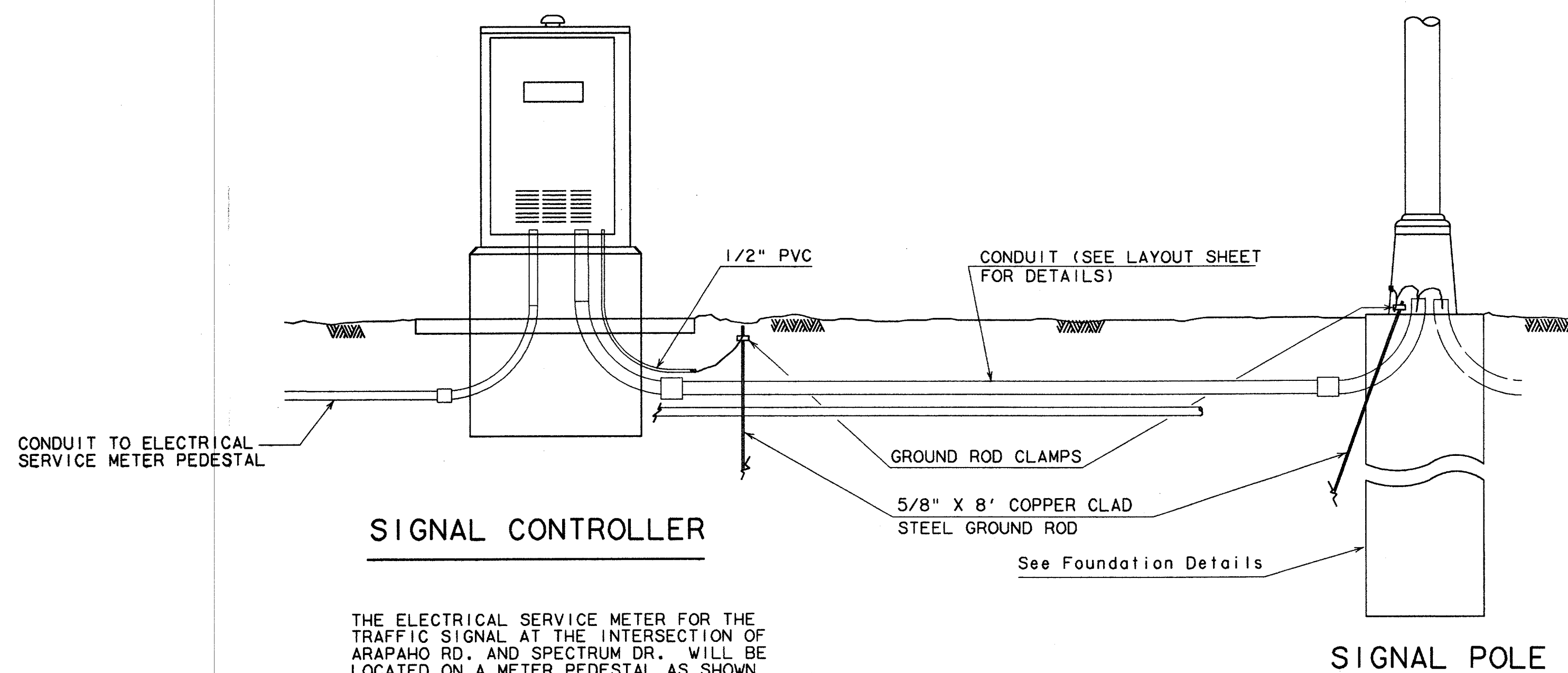
