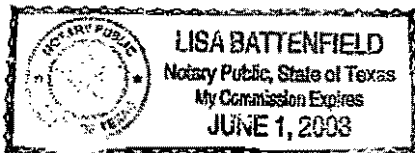

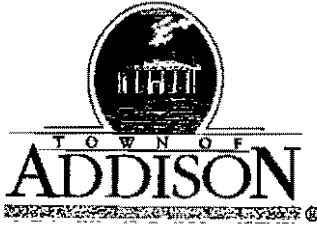

The long awaited source water assessments for public water systems will be distributed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in the next few weeks. The assessments will provide public water systems a major tool for advancing ongoing efforts to protect public water supplies throughout the state. The comprehensive assessments represent years of research, analysis, and investigation by state officials, trade organizations, federal, state and local agencies, and water service providers. The assessments also represent implementation of one of the key features of the 1996 Amendments of the Federal Safe Drinking Water Act.

Provided in the form of a detailed report, the assessments will contain information specific to each public water system, its source waters, and substances of concern which may impact source waters. The specific nature of the information will enhance the ability of a public water system to protect its source waters and ensure its continued reliability. Public water systems that purchase all of their water from another system should contact their purveyor for assessment results.

The TCEQ staff will be available to assist public water system operators in understanding the technical information in the assessments and to explain how the information can be used to enhance water supply operations and implement source water protection programs. Information on possible sources of funding for source water protection programs will also be available. 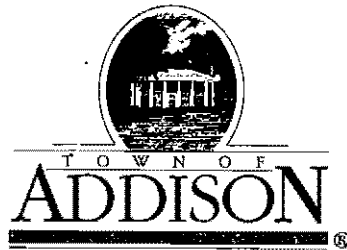

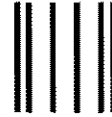

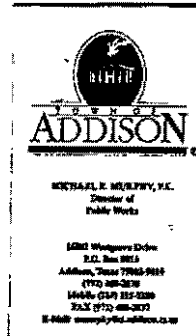
