

SUMMARY:

This item is to request Council approval to program \$1,290,000.00 of DART LAP/CMS funds for FY 2004.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Provides funds from DART that the Town can use for transportation related projects.

BACKGROUND:

Each year the Town receives a 15% "rebate" of the sales tax money we send to DART. This rebate program was designed to provide financial assistance and enhance mobility in DART member cities that do not have rail construction in progress. We have been receiving over one million dollars per year. This program expires in FY 2004, so this will be the last rebate we receive.

DART has advised that we can program and apply for \$1,290,000.00 of FY 2004 LAP/CMS funds at this time. These funds will be used for transit related projects in the Town of Addison.

We would like to program the following for FY 2004:

Arapaho Road Phase III	\$1,251,300.00
Technical Assistance (staff salaries)	\$38,700.00
	Total \$1,290,000.00

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends Council authorize staff to file the appropriate applications for the DART LAP/CMS funds for the projects listed above.

RESOLUTION NO. R03-085

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING TOWN OF ADDISON STAFF TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR DART LOCAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM/CONGESTION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (LAP/CMS) FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,290,000.00 FOR FY 2004.

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement between DART and Addison provides for an allocation of funds to Addison, from DART, based upon return of 15% of the DART sales tax collected from Addison for the previous 12 months; and

WHEREAS, this program will continue until 2004 or rail construction begins in Addison, whichever comes first; and

WHEREAS, the Town's allocation for FY 2004 is \$1,290,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Town has two projects for assistance under this program which will utilize the funds for Arapaho Road, Phase III and technical assistance; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

THAT, the City Council does hereby authorize Town of Addison staff to make application for DART Local Assistance Program/Congestion Management System (LAP/CMS) Funds in the amount of \$1,290,000.00 for FY 2004 for transportation related projects.
